### **'anti bullying interventions in schools what works**

**June 2nd, 2020 - bullying in schools is an ongoing issue with significant negative long term consequences for the students involved a large and growing body of research indicates that although bullying is a difficult problem to shift school based interventions can be successful in reducing bullying behaviours evidence indicates that bullying is"bullying is still rife in schools here s how teachers can**

**June 3rd, 2020 - my most recent intervention included 13 schools over a period of five months and found that the most effective approaches enable children to play a leading role in resolving bullying'**

**June 3rd, 2020 - to ensure that bullying prevention efforts are successful all school staff need to be trained on what bullying is what the school s policies and rules are and how to enforce the rules training may take many forms staff meetings one day training sessions and teaching through modeling preferred behavior'**

**June 3rd, 2020 - schools need greater support to maximise the outcomes of anti bullying interventions and to identify what is likely to be successful based on their specific contexts and requirements there is very little available currently in the way of specific advice to guide schools in their choice of anti bullying programs'**

**'treatment interventions for the victim of bullying**

**June 1st, 2020 - school wide intervention programs have been shown to reduce bullying by as much as 70% Olweus 2002 Olweus 1993 created an anti bullying program for schools that included having a school wide assembly on the topic of bullying involving the teachers in games and activities during lunch and recess dedicating class time to the teaching of "bullying intervention plan St Mary's school**

**June 2nd, 2020 - the bullying prevention and intervention incident reporting form is to be completed and placed in a confidential locked file a school staff member is required to report immediately to the principal or designee any instance of bullying or retaliation the staff member becomes aware of or witnesses reports made by students parents or guardians or other individuals who are not school staff members may be made anonymously'**

June 1st, 2020 - the United States federal government has put forth recommendations for best practices in bullying prevention and intervention mit to creating and sustaining a positive school environment in your school form or identify existing team to coordinate bullying prevention efforts regularly assess and "how to stop bullying in school an evidence based guide

June 3rd, 2020 - for example the Olweus program is a whole school anti bullying intervention developed and tested in Norway Olweus 1994 it has had great success in its home country Olweus et al 2019 and it has reduced rates of bullying in some American schools e.g. Limber et al 2018'

## 'bullying and cyberbullying prevention in schools

June 1st, 2020 - examples include examining school rules and using behavior management techniques and social emotional learning in the classroom and throughout the school to detect and provide consequences for bullying school wide prevention activities that include improving the school climate strengthening supervision of students and having a school wide anti bullying policy'

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
