June 2nd, 2020 - the united nations

declaration on the rights of indigenous peoples undrip is an international instrument adopted by the united nations on september 13 2007 to enshrine according to article 43 the rights that constitute the minimum standards for the survival dignity and well being of the indigenous peoples of the world'' ***indigenous peoples issues in international and domestic***
